

Quarter Days Students Expectations

1. If you sign up, your parent must be willing and prepared to be a chaperone for one shift. Only two parents are needed, but they will be chosen on a rotating basis to be fair.
2. Sign up ahead of time in the band room. Please do not expect to simply “show up” at the fundraiser and participate.
3. If for some reason you signed up and cannot attend, please notify Suzie Moore (see contact information below) as soon as possible!! There may be an alternate who can take your place. Since so many students want to participate, it would be disappointing to let a slot go unfilled.
4. Arrive 15 minutes before your shift starts, and expect to help set up.
5. You **MUST** bring your instrument. No instrument, no pay.
6. Expect to work every minute of your shift. There will be a sign-in/out sheet at the site. This is your timecard. Without it, you will not get paid for your hard effort.
7. No phone breaks or visiting with friends. You will be allowed breaks and are encouraged to bring water. Snacks are also allowed.
8. Dress appropriately: Black band shirt, blue jeans and tennis shoes. No flip-flops or sandals.

It's ALWAYS important to remember that:

- You are an ambassador for the band. Behave in ways that promote the positive image of the band.
- You are mindful of your manner and language.
- People are more likely to donate money when they see your Motivation-Dedication-Discipline.
