SHS BPA BOARD MINUTES - October 13, 2015

<u>Call to Order</u>: The meeting was called to order by President Jen Polk at 6:37 pm.

<u>Director's Report</u>: PL Malcolm, Andrea Newhouse

- ➤ We are in mid-marching season. Going well. We might be in a post season. Got a nice thank you note from Millenium Middle regarding MS Night. It went smoothly, plenty of volunteers, no rain, more kids this year than in the past. Put the 3rd song on the field. MPA in two weeks. Kids are working hard. The calendar is up to date. Epcot tentative discussed option of taking a day out of school to attend OR to do the parade on Saturday December 19th during winter break. After discussion the decision was made to make a tentative date of December 19th.
- The Veteran's Day concert is scheduled for Tuesday November 10th (we will be rescheduling the BPA meeting to a week earlier to avoid a conflict). Maddie O'Brien is working on a flyer. This is something that works really well at UCF and equipment staff would like to try it out to see how it works for the Pride. They will put 6 coolers out and give it a try.

Cheryl mentioned that there is a need to get a lot more dots this year (since they ran out of supplies last year when they were matting the pictures.)
