

How to Sign-up for a SHS Band QUARTER DAY

"Quarter Days" are a great way for students to earn money for their individual student accounts (for band fees and trips)!

With SHS Band Quarter Days, students have the opportunity to sign-up for shifts (typically 4 hours) to represent the Seminole High School Band by playing their instrument, talking with the public and accepting public donations in support of the band. We schedule "Quarter Days" on weekends, all around town, typically at local grocery stores and retailers, throughout the year.

Students (and parent chaperones) can sign-up for Quarter Days by viewing the Quarter Days schedule (on the SHS Band website) and then by emailing the Quarter Day Coordinator to request a Quarter Day shift.

To View the Current Quarter Day Schedule:

- 2. Then click on Fund Raising and then on Quarter Days

To sign up for Quarter Days please email quarterdays@seminolehsband.org Provide your full name, contact number, chaperone information, date, location and shift you are interested in. The Quarter Day Coordinator will respond to you soon after. Chaperones and students should familiarize themselves with the Quarter Day expectations sheets on the band website. PLEASE make sure you are signed up to be a Dividend before working your first Quarter Days. This can be done also through the band website.

- 4. Yellow cells, labeled "open" are shifts that are available.
- 5. Identify a shift that you want to fill and send an email to the Quarter Days Coordinator at: guarterdays@seminolehsband.org

Be sure to include the following information in your email request: Your Name, the Day and Shift (time) that you wish to fill and your contact information (email and cell #).

- 6. You will receive an email back, confirming your assigned shift (please know that requests are filled on a first-request basis).
- 7. You will also, typically, receive a reminder email, the day prior to your assigned Quarter Day shift. But remember.....IT IS EACH STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO REMEMBER THEIR ASSIGNED QD SHIFTS AND TO SHOW UP, ON-TIME AND PREPARED TO FULLY PARTICIPATE.
- 8. Note the Quarter Day Student and Chaperone documents on the website these docs detail the expectations for all students and chaperones participating in Quarter Days.....please review this important information before participating.

Parents....please plan to volunteer to chaperone with your student at Quarter Days....we can't do a Quarter Day without chaperones!
