The meeting opened at 6:33 pm.

Mike Johansmeyer opened the meeting by welcoming everyone and making sure there was a quorum. The members present introduced themselves.

Secretary's' Report

Mike Johansmeyer read the minutes from the May meeting. The board voted on and approved the minutes.

Treasurer's Report

Jen Polk said that as of April 30th the ending balance in the BPA account was \$22,766.33. As of today the balance was \$24,953.88. The trip account as of April 30th was \$42,445.48; as of today because of paying for the D.C. trip it was \$19,667.25. Mike said that fundraising will be very important as we begin the year since there are several purchases which need to be made. Jen said that the end of the year is June 30th and she is working to close the books but we should end up close to the amount we have now. She is going on vacation and would like everything into her by the 24th.

Mike asked Mr. Malcolm if he had any recommendations for an account to do the taxes and he recommended Steve Hartstocks.

Jen explained how the budget was formed and Mike called for a vote on approving the budget. Budget passed unanimously. Jen said the budget could be ratified at the meeting at the last day of band camp.

Mike said that he would like the members identified at the meetings and PL suggested colored notecards. Mike explained the new Google drive that has different forms and information and is open to all board members.

Procedures Manual

Mike said that he has received five manuals from Photo, Equipment, Web, Secretary, and Quarter Days. Photo and Equipment are done so we are well on our way. Mike will be starting a President's notebook to give tip for the next board. He would like everyone to find someone to mentor for the next year.

Band Camp

Registration Committee
