Director's Report

Mr. Malcolm said that it has been a great year.

Treasurer's Report

Jen Polk said that as of April 30th the ending balance in the BPA account was \$22,766.33. As of today at 1:30 the balance was \$34,730.96. The trip account as of April 30th was \$42,445.48; as of 1:30 today it was \$26,041.91.

Jill McAuley said the amount of dues still owed is \$4193.00. She said that of those students that still owed money, eight have relocated. She will be turning over the debts with the student names to the front office and she contacted everyone who still owes money.

Chris Proudfoot said that 17 students still owe \$30 for the DC trip.

Committee Reports

Chaperone Committee

Matt Polk would like to know how many chaperones are needed for registration and band camp and he would like to have a list of all band parents next year. He said he would like to have all parents volunteer at least once a year. He suggested that if parents don't want to volunteer they could pay \$25. He said that the Sanford Police Department will be at the busses to scan the luggage before the DC trip. The chaperones will search the bags if they find anything.

Uniform report
