CALL TO ORDER: Candice Vild called the meeting to order at 6:11PM

PRESENTATION OF MINUTES: Minutes from the previous meeting were presented and approved (motion: Gena Bukar, second: Jill McAuley)

DIRECTOR'S REPORT: presented by Mr. Malcolm

Thank you for amending our meeting time. Our concert MPA was a few weeks ago. We are both very proud of the performances. Although the ratings were not the highest, we feel fortunate because of who was judging. Five to ten bands that received superiors last year did not get superiors this year. Concert band was the most improved of the group. All three bands earned superiors for sight-reading. Mr. Labonte did a great job in his first year.

We are in the process of preparing for our Japanese guests who will be here in less than two weeks. We are very excited for this concert and their visit. Mr. Malcolm shared that the students have written notes about how excited they are about coming to visit that are included with their bios. It'll be a whirlwind two days at Seminole. They arrive on Saturday afternoon they'll do a rehearsal, introductions, potluck then concert. Sunday is home stay visits – breakfast, outings, etc. Monday the students will return to Seminole. Jazz Band and Drum line will play for them before they leave. On Tuesday they'll have a day concert at Seabreeze High. Tuesday night they'll play at Deland High School. On Wednesday they'll march at Epcot (we'll loan them some of our equipment to march in the parade). This is a world-class high school band. They are considered to be one of Japan's finest. Their conductor is considered to be one of Japan's best.

Next week we have State Solo and Ensemble at Lake Nona. We're working on getting that figured out since it's over spring break. We've been asked to host next year's State Solo and Ensemble over spring break. We'll talk about it at a future date.
