CALL TO ORDER: Gena Bukur called the meeting to order @6:38PM (motion: Chris, second: Jill)

DIRECTOR'S REPORT: PL Malcolm, Cheyne LaBonte

- Past, Present, & Future:

- Marching Fest is this Saturday, there will be at least one run through practice session in the morning
- Huge thank you to the Bukur family, the McAuley family, and the Malcolm family for all of the time and work they've put into this season in prepping the props for our halftime show.
- We are not attending the Spruce Creek game this year.
- As it stands right now, our football team is undefeated. We do have the potential to go into the playoffs. November 1st is our BYE week, first playoff game would be November 8. After the regular season ends, there will be no more marching rehearsals. Because the band will no longer be rehearsing the halftime show following marching MPAs, we more than likely will not perform the halftime show in more than two post season games.

Color Guard/Winter Guard report (Brynne Estremo): Ms. Estremo reports that the following expenses are expected for this upcoming season of Winter Guard:

- FFCC registration: \$600 (covers all competition entry costs)
- Floor tarp: \$1925
- Uniforms: \$70 per person (plans on having returning members reuse their shoes, undergarments, and makeup kits from fall)
- Equipment: \$40 per person (flags, etc)

Winter Guard auditions will be held on October 21 and October 28. She is hoping to add 28-30 kids to the squad this season.

This year, instead of doing a full meal, the events committee has opted to go with appetizers and desserts. They will need help picking donations up on the day of the event.
