For our last month together of the 2019/2020 school year, we are going to focus mostly on our final projects that we started in week 4. Students need to be designing their own winter guard show. So far, we have asked you all to turn in your song, floor, uniform, flags, hair and make up designs to make sure that you are all on the right track.

Most of you have received feedback on your designs and suggestions on how to improve these. A rubric on what concepts we'd like to see you develop through this project is posted on the online assignments page, so please check that out if you have any questions. The rubric will also explain what components need to be included when you turn in your final project.

Below you will find a schedule of what will be due and when:

Friday, May 8th @ 12 noon-

1. 32 counts of choreography. This will be an original piece written by the student, starting anywhere in the song that was submitted in week 4. Flag or weapon only.

Friday, May 15th -

1. Second 32 counts of choreography. Needs to add on to the first 32 counts that were submitted.

2. Two winter-style drill charts. These need to correspond to floor designs that were submitted in week 4. Designate any differences in equipment or choreography that will be going on at that time, and that paths of movement between the two charts.

Friday, May 22nd -

1. Third 32 counts of choreography.

2. Two more winter-style drill charts.
