# SHS BPA MEETING MINUTES | OCTOBER 13 2020

CALL TO ORDER: Gena Bukur called the meeting to order @6:47PM

**PRESENTATION OF MINUTES:** Minutes from the previous meeting were approved and filed

**DIRECTOR'S REPORT:** PL Malcolm, Cheyne LaBonte (Past, Present, & Future)

- We have successfully completed the first 9 weeks of the 2020-2021 school year. The face to face learners have been respectful and have been following the rules and guidelines that the school and the band directors have put forth for their safety. The band directors are noticing that it does seem to be harder for the at home learners to stay motivated and to establish a routine and some structure. Overall, the kids are learning how to cope and to adapt, kindness is being offered more and more. "We are teaching our kids," Mr. Malcolm reports. "Maybe it's not the typical lesson, but they're learning." The kids do seem happier now that they have begun playing again.
- Senior Night is upcoming. In regards to the last minute switch of the date, the last minute nature of the communication regarding the need for our parents to purchase tickets to attend this game and the timing of when they were requiring our senior parents to report to and be announced during this evening contributed to the decision to switch the date and the band holding its own separate senior night. There are several other things that are going to differentiate senior night this year from previous years' events, mainly due to the fact that some of the things we usually do for our seniors and their families are not feasible during the current health crisis and don't fall within the guidelines that the county and school are expecting us to follow. The senior committee has made some alternative plans to deal with the unexpected shift from our normal routine, in order to still honor our senior class participants.
- Pep Band game plan: pep band A & B. PBA plays during Q1, PBB plays during Q2.

During halftime and through Q3, the band and guard members will be chaperoned to restrooms and to concession stands, if they need either, all other band and guard members will remain sequestered on the basketball court and reminded to maintain social distancing until the final two minutes of Q3, at which point all PBA, PBB, and guard members will play together.

## TREASURER'S REPORT: Mihaela LaFleur

The BPA bank account balances stand at approximately \$53,000 combined between both accounts. We have had an expense this past month purchasing instruments/accessories for percussion students, as well as the cost of the Chick Fil A sold at games. Income we have taken in this past month was from Chick Fil A sales and the dues that some students have turned in. Band directors suggest that the budget committee reconvene in January to re-examine the budget to determine if spring dues still need to be charged and if yes if there is a way that we may be able to discount the amount asked for. We are still in need of an accounts receivable treasurer.
