SHS BPA MEETING MINUTES | JULY 13, 2021

CALL TO ORDER: Mandy Burkhart called the meeting to order @6:33PM

PRESENTATION OF MINUTES: Minutes from the previous meeting were approved and filed

DIRECTOR'S REPORT: PL Malcolm, Cheyne LaBonte (Past, Present, & Future)

- Everyone had a great summer and now looking forward to returning to a normal for Band Camp, football games and school year.
- Band camp is approaching with a smaller start. Continued push to be positive, encouraging and keep our standards high as we move forward
- FBA Summer, Dayton Beach biggest takeaway Band Directors from all over were feeling the same.
- 2021 Halftime theme James Bond
- Dividends registration opens July 18th.
- Practice field will be getting a scaffolding tower
- Drum Majors are at FSU Leadership camp and working hard to be ready for this season.
- Discussing going back to using remind

TREASURER'S REPORT: Mihaela LaFleur

• The BPA bank account balances stand at approximately \$51,000 combined between both accounts. 20-21 expenses had bills of no more than \$100 and expenses of \$375 for a clinician and \$234 Xerox (disused this was higher due to printing for band banquet. 21-22 expenses consisted of \$1,9687 for Color Guard uniforms and \$1,400 FSU leadership camp for Drum majors. Collections of band dues during spring camp was no more than \$2000. Recommend submitting debt owed report to school before parking passes are handed out.

OLD BUSINESS:

Discussion to relook at Band Banquet venue for this year. It was agreed that the food was less than desirable. A venue where we could bring in a cater might work better. Agreed to explore looking for venues that could hold up to 200 people in the local area. Possible venues: Lake Mary Events Center or the Sanford Civic Center.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

• Operations: Chris purchased new sprayers for band camp. Sadly, a ton of snow cone syrup had expired and needed to be disposed of. A decision was made to limit the number of flavors ordered to avoid this in the future. Chris recommends 4 be the magic number of syrups. Syrup flavors to be order are Blue Raspberry, Cherry, Tiger Blood and Pina Colada. Chris will be plugging the machine in to make sure it still functions properly during band camp. A request for donations of cases of water bottles as gone out. Chris is working out the final details of band camp dinners (Chick-fil-a, pizza, Arby, Taco Bell and Grilling (hamburgers and hot dogs) Chris will check on the cookie, chips and ice for band camp week. Chris is looking into pricing of a new ice machine

Possibly around 3,900 plus install between 1400-1500. New ice machine would be used for Friday football games and snow cones.

- Band Camp: Band camp in the fall is scheduled for July 26-30, from 9AM-9PM each day. Hopoewaw day (for incoming 9th graders and new band members only) will be July 24. July 20-23 will be percussion/guard and leadership camps. July 22: Returning Members Registration Night and July 23: New Members Registration Night. Need to find Notaries for registration nights. A hard copy of emergency/medical forms need to be kept and notarized. Mandy and James are working on making some of the registration forms online or google forms. Registration night payment alternatives for cash or check are venmo/paypal/ cash app
- Chaperones/Volunteers: Dividends registration opens July 18th. Anyone looking to volunteer for band camp should apply to dividend as soon as possible. Joe will be setting up a singupgenius for Band camp volunteers and donations needed for Band Camp. Volunteer times will be split into three shifts per day. Football games are back to normal for chaperones. Home games approximately 19 chaperones needed. Away games 2 chaperones per bus. Possible Chaperone/Volunteer mixer with a possible date of Aug 20th. More information to follow at the next meeting. Middle school night is Sept 10th.
- **Fundraising:** Little Caesar's make your own pizza/breadsticks kits were not as successful as we had hoped. It could have been timing, possibly try it again around spring break or solo and ensembles. Ideas for adding a Band ornament to the Christmas tree and poinsettia fundraiser. Band Directors are looking into bring back Quarterdays.
- **Events**: Middle school night is Sept 10th. Band Directors discussing submitting for spring break trip once school starts. Could take 2 school board meeting before getting approved.
- **Equipment:** Chris Flynn is going to look into the purchase of an ice machine, for band usage.
- Media: Allison is looking for more people to help take photos. Please get the word out.
- **Uniforms:** looking into replacement order for hats, gauntlets and possibly a made to order uniform. LaBonte stated plumes were checked in May and everything looked good.
- **Tech Support**: no report

- Guard: Get to know information session at 7:30 tonight. Thank you Ms Smith is doing an amazing job getting Color Guard ready for this upcoming year. Show uniforms were ordered June 30th. They should be in for the 2nd football game. Discuss the need for uniform for Parades and pep rallies. This uniform has a 8 week lead time. Discussed ordering Flags (4 week lead time). Directors to discuss candidate search for an instructor. Budget for guard assessment still under review. Board to look at adding a line item in budget for guard. Color Guard takes on two different functions (Fall and then Spring).
