SHS BPA MEETING MINUTES | May 21st, 2023

- Congratulations to Seniors and all for making it to the official end of 22-23 school year.
- MS band camp was hosted at SHS for the past 2 weeks, very successful. The concert was great, band stronger than last year. Numbers were down from 100 to about 80, need more recruiting for this program. 10-20 volunteers every day, sometimes they were teaching. Clinicians spoke highly of our SHS volunteers. Earned a couple hundred dollars in concessions.
- Marching leadership camp at Lake Howell- several students attended.
- Both band directors and Coach P met with a drill designer.

- Football schedule -The first full week of school kickoff will be at home- we will participate as pep band in khaki shorts and polos. August 18th against Edgewater. Next 2 games also at home, may continue shorts and polos due to heat 8/25 & 9/1. Then next 3 games are far away, band will probably not travel (9/8, 9/15 & 9/22)
- Seminole county working on RFP for band uniform purchasing, our design will be up in January 2024
- Mr. Malcolm headed to Rome for a site tour, very pleased with the travel company.
